- Tri-Joint Drainage District Number 17 is a legally-established drainage district under the control of the Winnebago County Board of Supervisors, as provided in Iowa Code section 468.
- 2. The District crosses Iowa Hwy. 9, located at Sta. 1786+32 (+/-), and as shown on the plans for the highway improvement project. The highway is under the jurisdiction and supervision of the Department.
- The Department currently maintains certain bridges, culverts and structures across the right of way located within the limits of the drainage district to provide for vehicular traffic on the highway and permit free passage of water in the drainage district area.
- 4. The Department desires to replace the existing 80'x30' steel girder and floor beam bridge with a triple 10'x12' RCB culvert, and as shown on the plans for the highway improvement project.
- 5. The Department agrees to design and pay for the installation of the bridges, culverts, structures, and other construction in connection with the project, and agrees the design and installation of the improvements will be performed in such a manner to cause a minimum of obstruction and impediment to the flow of water in the open ditches of the district.
