Voter pre-registration deadline is 5:00 pm May 23, 2022 at the Winnebago County Auditor's office.

Absentee ballots are available in the County Auditor's office during regular business hours.

Pre-registered voters are required to provide an approved form of identification at the polling place before receiving and casting a ballot. Voters who are not pre-registered – such as voters registering to vote on Election Day – and voters changing precincts must also provide proof of residence. A voter who is unable to provide an approved form of identification (or prove residence if required) 1) may have the voter's identity/residence attested to by another registered voter in the precinct, 2) prove identity and residence using Election Day Registration documents, or 3) cast a provisional ballot and provide proof of identity/residence at the county auditor's office by June 9, 2022 at 12:00 pm. Election Day Registrant attestors must provide an approved form of identification.
