

IT SHALL BE THE POLICY of Winnebago County to permit the application of dust palliative agents for the control of dust on loose-surfaced county roads. All pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 318 of the Code of Iowa (Obstructions in Highways)

Winnebago County requires a permit to be filed with the Engineer's office before applicants receive dust control. Permit applications are available from approved contractors or the Engineer's office.

- Permit fees shall be \$25.00 for all permits received prior to May 15th. Permits received after May 15th will have an additional \$25.00 fee charged.
- All fees will be collected by the contractor and submitted to Winnebago County along with the completed permits.
- All permits must be signed by the applicant, not the contractor.
- Material may be applied from May 15th to September 30th upon approval of the permits and at the discretion of the County Engineer.
- The Engineer's office will be notified in advance of each application so that the roadway may be properly shaped.
- Winnebago County reserves the right to re-work the treated areas and maintain them as loose granular surfaces if the owner fails to maintain the area in a condition acceptable to the County.

SPECIFICATIONS AND CONDITIONS OF PERMIT:

The application and maintenance of chemicals on crushed rock surfaced roads to control dust shall be by permit only and in accordance with the following specifications and conditions.

1. The material approved for use on the roads is Lignin Sulfonate or Magnesium Chloride.
2. Dust Control material may be applied from May 15th to September 30th only. This permit expires October 1st.
3. Winnebago County reserves the right to re-work the treated areas and maintain them as loose granular surfaces if the owner fails to maintain the area in a condition acceptable to the County.
4. Winnebago County Engineer's Office shall be notified three (3) working days in advance of each application of the dust control agent so that the roadway may be properly shaped.
5. Permit fee shall be \$25.00 for all permits received prior to May 15th. Permits received after May 15th will have an additional \$25.00 fee charged. Fees will be collected by the contractor.

CONTRACTORS: The contractor's material, application rate and performance shall be subject to owner-contractor agreements.
