The Winnebago County Board of Supervisors met in session at 9:00 A.M. September 29, 2015 adjourned from September 22, 2015.

Present: Supervisors Jensvold, Stensrud, and Durby

Absent:

On a motion by Jensvold and seconded by Stensrud the Supervisors moved to approve the minutes for the September 22, 2015 Board Meeting and approve the agenda for September 29, 2015. All voted aye. Motion carried.

Julie Swenson, Treasurer discussed a property in Rake. The homeowner is wanting to make payments on a tax certificate held by Winnebago County. Swenson is asking the Board to waive the penalties and costs associated with the tax certificate. The Board agreed to waive the penalties and costs when the homeowner comes up with a payment plan.

On a motion by Jensvold and seconded by Stensrud the Supervisors moved to approve a Liquor License for the Dollar General store in Buffalo Center, Iowa. All voted aye. Motion carried. The Board was given information the land for the Dollar General building was annexed into the city of Buffalo Center. Dollar General will have to apply for the Liquor License from the city. On a motion by Jensvold and seconded by Stensrud the Supervisors moved to rescind the approval for the Liquor License for the Dollar General store in Buffalo Center, Iowa. All voted aye. Motion carried.

On a motion by Durby and seconded by Jensvold the Supervisors moved to approve Ordinance No. 39 (Ordinance to establish road and bridge standards). All voted aye. Motion carried.

Scott Meinders, Engineer discussed Secondary Road matters including edge rutting, shoulder work, and fall mowing.

A REAP report from Conservation was given to the Board of Supervisors for their approval. On a motion by Jensvold and seconded by Stensrud the Supervisors moved to approve the REAP report for FY 2015. All voted aye. Motion carried.

The Board of Supervisors went into recess at 9:45 and came back into session at 11:30.

The real estate closing documents for the Meinecke – Winnebago County property were distributed to the Supervisors for review. On a motion by Stensrud and seconded by Jensvold the Supervisors moved to approve the closing documents as written. All

voted aye. Motion carried. On a motion by Stensrud and seconded by Jensvold the Supervisors moved to approve Terry Durby, Chairman to sign the Closing Statement portion of the closing documents. All voted aye. Motion carried.
