The Winnebago County Board of Supervisors met in session at 9:00 A.M. February 14, 2023 adjourned from February 7, 2023.

Present: Supervisors Smith, Jensvold, and Durby

Absent:

On a motion by Smith and seconded by Durby the Supervisors moved to approve the minutes for the February 7, 2023 Board Meeting and approve the Agenda for February 14, 2023. All voted aye. Motion carried.

Ethan Schutter, Maintenance Supervisor discussed Secondary Road matters including stock piling rock and maintaining roads. Working on plans for Forest City shop then bid letting will take place.

Ethan Schutter answered questions regarding the Secondary Roads Five Year Program including pavement preservation, bridges, and micro resurfacing.

Julie Sorenson, Public Health discussed the public health addition project.

Kris Oswald, Drainage Clerk discussed drainage matters including DD 76 is a Trustee District that wishes to dissolve and have it become a Supervisor Trustee District. Oswald also discussed DD 86 and the need for it to be reclassified before any project is done. The classification is not equitable.

On a motion by Durby and seconded by Smith the Supervisors approved signing on to the new opioid settlement. All voted aye. Motion carried.

There was discussion regarding the Rural Recycling. The Supervisors discussed a single drop site and having a discussion next week with Scott Levine.

On a motion by Durby and seconded by Smith the Supervisors moved to approve the payroll claims. All voted aye. Motion carried.
