

May 9, 2023

The Winnebago County Board of Supervisors met in session at 9:00 A.M. May 9, 2023 adjourned from May 2, 2023.

Present: Supervisors Durby, Smith, and Jensvold.

Absent:

On a motion by Smith and seconded by Durby the Supervisors moved to approve the Minutes from the May 2, 2023 Board Meeting and approve the Agenda for May 9, 2023. All voted aye. Motion carried.

Assured Partners discussed the health insurance options. On a motion by Smith and seconded by Durby the Supervisors moved to approve the insurance plan presented by Assured Partners last week except for the change in co-pays. All voted aye. Motion carried.

Scott Meinders, Engineer discussed Secondary Road matters including hauling rock, and gravel crushing will be going on until about Memorial Day.

Meinders discussed the bridge near 3 Fingers Campground on 135th Avenue, Section 29, Forest Township. This bridge is the landowner's only way to their home. Another person would like to build a house out there and with the bridge posted that would not be able to happen. The bridge will need to be replaced in FY 2024.

Kris Oswald, Drainage Clerk discussed drainage matters.

At 9:30 A.M. on a motion by Durby and seconded by Smith the Supervisors moved to open the Public Hearing to abandon DD 2-3 Lat 2B1 Tile. All voted aye. Motion carried. Present at the hearing were Supervisors Jensvold, Durby and Smith, Karla Weiss, Auditor, Kris Oswald, Drainage Clerk, Ben Dontje, AJ Taylor, Julie Sorenson, Kevin Williams, Ethan Schutter, Maintenance Supervisor, Jonathan Kirchner, and Scott Meinders, Engineer. There was one objection from Engineer Scott Meinders. On a motion by Smith and seconded by Durby the Supervisors moved to close the Public Hearing. All voted aye. Motion carried. On a motion by Smith and seconded by Durby the Supervisors moved to abandon DD 2-3 Lat 2B1 Tile. All voted aye. Motion carried.

On a motion by Jensvold and seconded by Durby the Supervisors moved to set a Public Hearing for an anhydrous ammonia storage and pumping facility for May 30, 2023 at 9:15 A.M. All voted aye. Motion carried.

On a motion by Smith and seconded by Durby the Supervisors moved to set a Public Hearing for the FY 23 Budget Amendment for May 30, 2023 at 9:00 A.M. All voted aye. Motion carried.

The Forest City EMS came in to ask some questions of the Supervisors. The Supervisors are discussing an amount with the City of Forest City to help fund the Paramedic program. The Forest City Ambulance would like to know how much that amount will be by June 1, 2023. The Supervisors are going to provide money for Buffalo Center and their Ambulance Service and Lake Mills and their Ambulance Service to hire an EMT up to a Paramedic for their communities. The County wide program will start July 1, 2023.

Julie Sorenson, Public Health asked the Sanitarian position discussion be tabled until next week.

On a motion by Durby and seconded by Jensvold the Supervisors moved to approve the following Resolution. All voted aye. Motion carried.

COUNTY BUDGET RESOLUTION
Resolution 04-18-2023-01-01

BE IT REMEMBERED that on the 18th day of April, 2023 the Board of Supervisors of Winnebago County, Iowa met in session for the purpose of a hearing upon the budget estimate as filed with this Board along with the intent to levy general basic property tax rates and rural basic property tax rates which exceed statutory maximums. Thereupon, the Board investigated and found that the notice of the time and place of hearing had, according to law and as directed by the Board, been published on the 29th day of March, 2023 in the Lake Mills Graphic and Buffalo Center Tribune, official newspapers published in said County, and that the affidavits of Publication thereof were on file with the County Auditor. The Public Hearing on the budget was held on April 18, 2023. Thereafter on April 18, 2023 the estimate was taken up and considered. The Auditor and Board of Supervisors reviewed the budget. There were no objections to the proposed budget.

THEREAFTER and after hearing all taxpayers desiring to be heard, the Board took up the estimate for final consideration and after being fully advised, the Board determined that said estimate be completed so that when completed it should be in words and figures as follows:


County levy against city property of 10.49405/\$1000 valuation
County levy against rural property of 15.52236/\$1000 valuation


Total County Budget tax asking is \$9,139,825 FY July 1, 2023 - June 30, 2024.

The vote on final adoption of the budget was as follows:


