Resolution Awarding General Obligation Urban Renewal Bonds, Series 2024

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors (the "Board") of Winnebago County, Iowa (the "County"), heretofore proposed to enter into a General Obligation Urban Renewal Loan Agreement (the "Loan Agreement") and to issue general obligation bonds in a principal amount not to exceed \$6,200,000 pursuant to the provisions of Subsection 331.441(2)(b)(14), Section 331.402, Section 331.442, and Chapter 403 of the Code of Iowa, for the purpose of paying the cost, to that extent, of undertaking the Winnebago County Road and Bridge Improvement Projects, and urban renewal project of the county authorized by action of the Board of Supervisors on July 2, 2024, and in lieu of calling an election upon such proposal, has published notice of the proposed action and has held a hearing thereon, and as of August 13, 2024, no petition had been filed with the County asking that the question of entering into the Loan Agreement be submitted to the registered voters of the County; and

WHEREAS, a Preliminary Official Statement (the "P.O.S.") has been prepared to facilitate the sale of the General Obligation Urban Renewal Bonds, Series 2024 (the "Bonds") in evidence of the obligation of the County under the Loan Agreement, and the County has made provision for the approval of the P.O.S. and authorized its use by Speer Financial, Inc., as municipal financial advisor to the County; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to advertisement of sale, bids for the purchase of the Bonds were received and canvassed on behalf of the County and the substance of such bids noted in the minutes; and

WHEREAS, upon final consideration of all bids, the bid of Piper Sandler, Minneapolis, Minnesota (the "Purchaser"), is the best, such bid proposing the lowest interest cost to the County for the Bonds;

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Board of Supervisors of Winnebago County, Iowa, as follows:

Section 1. The bid of the Purchaser referred to in the preamble is hereby accepted, and the Bonds are hereby awarded to the Purchaser at the price specified in such bid, together with accrued interest, if any.

Section 2. The form of agreement of sale/official bid form (the "Sale Agreement") of the Bonds to the Purchaser is hereby approved, and the Chairperson and County Auditor are hereby authorized to execute the Sale Agreement for and on behalf of the County.

Section 3. Further action with respect to the approval of the Loan Agreement and the issuance of the Bonds is hereby adjourned to the Board of Supervisors meeting to be held on September 10, 2024.

Section 4. All resolutions or parts thereof in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 5. This resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption and approval, as provided by law.
