The Winnebago County Board of Supervisors met in session at 9:00 A.M. May 20, 2025, adjourned from May 13, 2025.

Present: Supervisors Durby, Smith, and Jensvold

Absent:

On a motion by Jensvold and seconded by Durby the Supervisors moved to approve the minutes for May 13, 2025, Board Meeting and approve the agenda for May 20, 2025. All voted aye. Motion carried.

Karla Weiss, Auditor discussed drainage matters, including DD 2 has a beaver dam.

Scott Meinders, Engineer and Ethan Schutter, Maintenance Superintendent, discussed Secondary Road matters including updates on the new building. Walls are up, roof sheeting is on, the cut for the windows are in the shop and office, and concrete is poured. TIF projects are going well.

On a motion by Durby and seconded by Jensvold the Supervisors moved to approve Change Order #2 for the Winnebago County Storage Building. All voted aye. Motion carried. This changes the insulation from bat insulation to spray foam.

On a motion by Jensvold and seconded by Durby the Supervisors moved to approve the federal agreement with the Iowa DOT for Project No. STP-CO95(88)-5E-95, A42. All voted aye. Motion carried.

During open forum there was discussion regarding the proposed E-911 bill. The Supervisors are suggesting the Sheriff's department send a letter to the Governor to ask for a line-item veto. There was discussion regarding the Medical Examiner position. There was discussion regarding purchasing gas locally.
