The Winnebago County Board of Supervisors met in session at 9:00 A.M. March 31, 2026 adjourned from March 24, 2026.

On a motion by Durby and seconded by Smith the Supervisors moved to approve the minutes for the March 24, 2026 Board Meetings and approve the Agenda for March 31, 2026. All voted aye. Motion carried.

Kris Oswald, Drainage Clerk discussed drainage matters.

Kris Oswald, Drainage Clerk discussed an updated classification schedule for DD 14 Lat 4 and Lat 4A. The engineering firm omitted one classification schedule in the previous reclassification. On a motion by Durby and seconded by Smith the Supervisors moved to approve the updated reclassification schedules for DD 14 Lat 4 and 4A. All voted aye. Motion carried.

On a motion by Durby and seconded by Smith the Supervisors moved to set the Public Hearing for the updated reclassification schedules for DD 14 Lat 4 and 4A for April 28, 2026 at 9:01 A.M. All voted aye. Motion carried.
