The Winnebago County Board of Supervisors met in session at 9:00 A.M. August 11, 2026, adjourned from August 4, 2026.

Present: Supervisors Jensvold, Durby, and Smith

Absent:

On a motion by Durby and seconded by Smith the Supervisors moved to approve the minutes for the August 4, 2026, Board Meeting and approve the Agenda for August 11, 2026. All voted aye. Motion carried.

At 9:00 A.M. on a motion by Durby and seconded by Smith the Supervisors moved to open the Public Hearing for Easement Agreement in Newton Township. All voted aye. Motion carried. Present at the hearing were Supervisors Durby, Smith and Jensvold, Auditor Karla Weiss, Chris Barber, Conservation, Bennie Hostetler, and Jason Hallberg. There was no public comment. On a motion by Durby and seconded by Smith the Supervisors moved to close the Public Hearing. All voted aye. Motion carried.

On a motion by Durby and seconded by Smith the Supervisors moved to approve the Easement Agreement in Newton Township. All voted aye. Motion carried.

At 10:00 A.M. there was discussion regarding the Bennie Hostetler property. The Supervisors decided on a fence for the property.

Kris Oswald, Drainage Clerk discussed Drainage matters including Durby wanting to have a culvert put in to the DD 1 repair. Helgeson Drainage will add the culvert to the repair estimate.

Scott Meinders, Engineer discussed Secondary Road matters including finishing the two box culverts south of Buffalo Center. They will be ordering the culvert for the next project. There was much discussion regarding dust control.

On a motion by Smith and seconded by Durby the Supervisors moved to approve the Auditors Transfer for \$11,549.25 from General Basic to Winn-Worth Betco. All voted aye. Motion carried.

On a motion by Durby and seconded by Smith the Supervisors moved to approve the payroll claims. All voted aye. Motion carried.
