**Filing period** for the June 7, 2022, Primary Election for Republican or Democratic candidates for the offices of Supervisor Districts 1 & 3, Attorney, Treasurer, and Recorder is **March 7 – March 25, 2022 (5:00 PM)**

The Secretary of State’s Office has advised that the Auditor’s Office can NOT accept nomination papers for the office of **County Supervisor** with fewer than 100 signatures. This change is stemming from the re-districting and re-precincting process due to the recent census. The Iowa Code is vague regarding pulling data from the most recent General Election when re-districting could possibly change the district boundaries. **Primary Election Candidate Qualifications**

County Supervisor	Citizen at the time of the election [§39.26]	Iowa resident at time of election. Registered voter of the county/supervisor district when sworn in. [§39.26, 331.201(2)]	18 at the time of the election [§39.26]	4 years	Plan 3 Counties: At least 100 or 2% of the party vote in the supervisor district (including election day and absentee) at last general election, whichever is less. [§43.20(1)(b)]

**43.20 Signatures required — more than one office prohibited.**

b. Nomination papers for an office to be filled by the voters of the county or for the office of county supervisor elected from a district within the county, shall be signed by at least two percent of the party vote in the county or supervisor district, as shown by the last general election, or by at least one hundred persons, whichever is less.
