Voter pre-registration deadline is 5:00 P.M. October 24, 2022 at the Winnebago County Auditor's office.

Absentee ballots are available in the County Auditor's office during regular business hours.

**Pre-registered voters are required to provide an approved form of identification at the polling place before receiving and casting a ballot. Voters who are not pre-registered – such as voters registering to vote on Election Day – and voters changing precincts must also provide proof of residence. A voter who is unable to provide an approved form of identification (or prove residence if required) 1) may have the voter's identity/residence attested to by another registered voter in the precinct, 2) prove identity and residence using Election Day Registration documents, or 3) cast a provisional ballot and provide proof of identity/residence at the county auditor's office by November 10, 2022 at 12:00 pm. Election Day Registrant attestors must provide an approved form of identification. Shall Board of Supervisors of Winnebago County, State of Iowa, be authorized to levy and impose a tax for the purpose of funding Emergency Medical Services in the county pursuant to Iowa Code Chapter 422D, in the amount of \$478,000 annually (ad valorem property tax not to exceed seventy-five cents (\$0.75) per one thousand dollars (\$1,000) of assessed value on all taxable property within the county and a local option income surtax of not to exceed one percent (1.0%) on the state individual income tax of each individual residing in the county at the end of the individual's applicable tax year) for a maximum period of fourteen (14) years?

### Certification of Constitutional Amendment – November 8, 2022, General Election

Shall the following amendment to the Constitution be adopted?

Summary: Provides that the right of the people of Iowa to keep and bear arms shall not be infringed. The sovereign state of Iowa affirms and recognizes the right to keep and bear arms as a fundamental right. Any and all restrictions of this right shall be subject to strict scrutiny.

Full text:

Article I of the Constitution of the State of Iowa is amended by adding the following new section: Right to keep and bear arms. Sec. 1A. The right of the people to keep and bear arms shall not be infringed. The sovereign state of Iowa affirms and recognizes this right to be a fundamental individual right. Any and all restrictions of this right shall be subject to strict scrutiny.
