- 1. Visitation is by video, and the length of visit is 20 minutes. Video visitation is controlled by computer and video will shut down automatically after 20 minutes. All visits are monitored and recorded.
- 2. Visits will be limited to a specific list of visitors identified on the inmate's visitation list. The list may be changed once a month. The Jail Staff will approve the list prior to visitation.
- 3. Inmates of the Winnebago County Jail released within the past 60 days will not be allowed to visit another inmate of the Winnebago County Jail. The Jail Administrator may make an exception for immediate family members.
- 4. Inmates on certain types of disciplinary restriction may not be permitted visitors.
- 5. If any officer has probable cause, he or she may search a visitor to ensure the security and orderly operation of the Jail.
- 6. Cell phones or other electronic devices are not allowed in the visitation area. Visitors must respect the privacy of other visitors in the video visitation room. All visitors are required to keep the visitation room clean and orderly.
- 7. Jail Staff will be in the facility area at all times during any visits. Visitation will be monitored.
- 8. A visit may be denied if reasonable suspicion exists that the visit might endanger the security of the facility, or the visitor does not have a photo ID. A record will be made of such denial and the reason.
- 9. Personal property for an inmate will not be accepted at the Jail, except for prescription Medications, cash for commissary, books to be donated to the library. Inmate is allowed a personal Bible and will be allowed to keep it.
- 10. Visitation may be cancelled, denied or revoked for loud conduct, misbehaving children, swearing, or any behavior which does not respect other people present. Inappropriate dress will be cause for denial of visitation.
- 11. Any lewd or sexual misconduct will result in a permanent ban from visitation. Misconduct will be determined by Jail staff.
