On a motion by Durby and seconded by Stensrud the Supervisors moved to approve the minutes for the October 10, 2017 Board Meeting and approve the agenda for October 17, 2017. All voted aye. Motion carried.

Dear County Social Services Board Members,

In accordance with Section IV (Duration) of the Intergovernmental Agreement Creating the County Social Services (CSS) dated April 1, 2014, Winnebago County is providing written notice of our intent to withdraw from the 28E Agreement effective June 30, 2018.

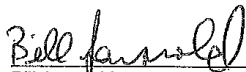
Winnebago County respectfully submits the following concerns for our notification:

1. **Accountability.** It has been apparent over the course of the last fiscal year that the size of the region (22 counties-largest in the state) is creating circumstances where services to clients is being compromised. Winnebago County questions capital building projects and Life Long Links contract.
2. **Staffing.** A recent reorganization plan currently being implemented focuses on specialty areas of services to the detriment of individual client services and the relationships of those clients to local staff.
3. **Funding.** Even though the 28E agreement establishes a per capita formula for funding, the description and availability of certain services and service locations discriminate against clients in rural settings. Ending fund balances should be maintained and managed by the member counties.
4. **Transparency.** In the above three aforementioned categories, inquiries have been made by member counties and individual elected officials of member counties. Data requested has either been not received in a timely manner, incomplete, or in some cases not provided.


For the above stated reasons, Winnebago County gives written notice to withdraw effective June 30, 2018.
