

November 28, 2017

The Winnebago County Board of Supervisors met in session at 9:00 A.M. November 28, 2017 adjourned from November 21, 2017.

Present: Supervisors Jensvold, Stensrud and Durby

Absent:

On a motion by Durby and seconded by Stensrud the Supervisors moved to approve the minutes for the November 21, 2017 Board Meeting and approve the agenda for November 28, 2017. All voted aye. Motion carried.

On a motion by Jensvold and seconded by Durby the Supervisors moved to approve a letter to be sent to local banks for quotes for interest rates for a general obligation bond loan. All voted aye. Motion carried.

On a motion by Durby and seconded by Stensrud the Supervisors moved to set the Public Hearing date for the General Obligation Bonds loan for December 27, 2017 at 10:00 A.M. All voted aye. Motion carried.

Supervisor Durby discussed a possible interested party in the former Law Enforcement Center building. Karla Weiss, Auditor, stated a parking lot may be a better use of the property. The Supervisors will discuss the issue again next week.

Scott Meinders, Engineer, discussed secondary road matters including the bridge by Leland.

At 9:30 A.M. there was a bid letting for the Sunnyside Farm lease in Forest Township, Section 30. There were two bids. The bidders were allowed to increase their bids by \$100 increments. The winning bid was to Brice Aukes for \$6,500 per year for three years. On a motion by Jensvold and seconded by Stensrud the Supervisors moved to approve the lease to Brice Aukes and authorize Scott Meinders, Engineer to execute a contract. All voted aye. Motion carried.

Kris Oswald, Drainage Clerk discussed drainage district matters.

On a motion by Stensrud and seconded by Durby the Supervisors moved to approve the payroll claims. All voted aye. Motion carried.

During open forum, Julie Sorenson discussed the MCO problem Public Health is having. AmeriHealth has pulled out of Iowa and Amerigroup will not take new patients. United Health Care is the only group left, but Iowa Medicaid has started taking patients again.

The session was adjourned until 9:00 A.M. December 4, 2017.
